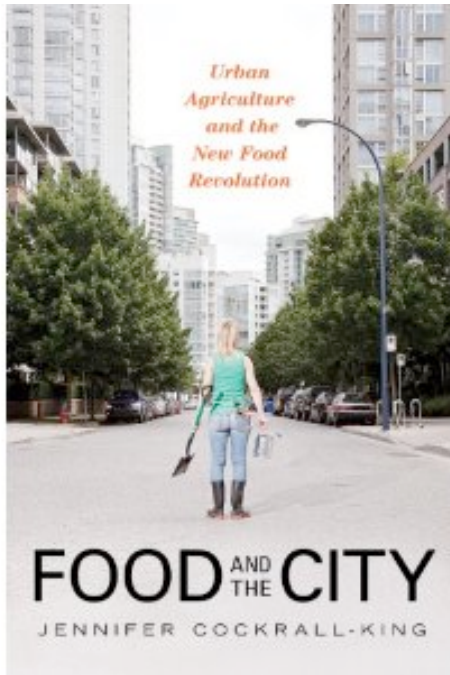


Queen Mary Park Community League Speaker Evening Tue. April 10, 2012, 7:30 – 9 p.m.
